Members mentioned that it would be a good idea to get a picture posted in the shed that shows how to mow the property and in which areas.

Brian Vanderpool is going to speak with a tree person about borrowing a stump remover to remove the old stumps from the broken down trees.

Marc Niehus reminded everyone that he will be repairing the grill. The frame needs work and will be strengthened.

#### **NEW BUSINESS -**

Bill Lee mentioned that we need to get more vests for the ditch clean up. We had a fantastic turn out. This is the first time we have run out of vests. Thank you very much to all of the members that assisted in this. It was huge and very much needed.

Scott mentioned that the pop machine will be filled soon. Weather has turned good for this. Scott reminded everyone to be very careful with the runway. It is still very soft and the fabric seems very brittle. If you are flying, please be aware of any new tears you might have created.

Dave Petsel reminded everyone that we might need to be replacing the runway. The board is looking into this. We will be rolling the field as soon as the soil dries enough with a heavy roller to smooth it out.

Scott Garrett motioned to spend up to \$100.00 for grass seed.

Roger Schultz reminded Gerald Hollander that we should reshoot the building for inside elevations now that the frost has gone out. Some discussion ensued regarding the possibility of moving the building. Financial preparations have started for this.

Roger asked if there are any other needs from the landfill to allow ditch cleaning to be safer. Roger mentioned to the landfill that we needed more vests, and that the lowa City police officer patrolling the highway during the cleaning was extremely helpful.

Bill Lee mentioned that the soil sample will be back this week and the fertilizer will be going down shortly.

## **Quick Notes/Reminders**

The ground under the runway is still very soft, so if you have to cross the runway or go out onto the runway to get a plane, please use the most direct route to lessen the chance of getting bumps in the runway. We will be rolling the runway later, when the ground dries up a little more

Also, we plan to set up an area to place the Gorilla Tape and Windex for easier access if a repair is needed of the runway fabric
