Propel on over to the clubhouse Tuesday, August 7th to finalize the airshow. We'll be wrapping candy for the Candy Drop at the meeting!



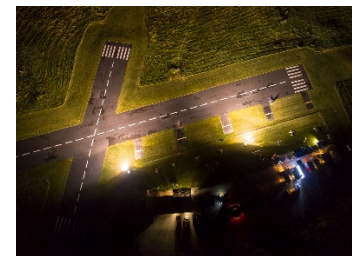
REFLECTION SECTION!
