A word of caution on using the new taxiways, taxing out from the pits is fine, however, taxing towards the pits is not allowed, always be in direct contact with your aircraft and bring it into the pits, do not taxi in, it just isn't safe.



While the new runways are still settling in, it would be advised not to walk on them during wet weather if at all possible. This will keep the runway as smooth as it looks in the picture for a long time to come. Also, there has been quite a bit of new grass planted in the pits and other areas. It would be very helpful to avoid the areas where the new grass has been planted to give it a chance to get a its roots down and filled in.

Motion to adjourn by David Petsel second by Shawn Shurson


